Track and Trace

We are asking parishioners to bring with them to Mass a piece of paper with their name and phone number on it every time they come to mass. If a family or group come together, only one contact number is needed. Anyone is free to decline to provide details and still attend Mass. Stewards will also be on hand (while observing social distancing) to write details down should you forget. These details will then be kept in the safe for 21 days for use to track and trace if necessary, before being destroyed
