Thought for the week 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time 13th August, 2023

"Oh God, come to my assistance; O Lord make haste to help me! You are my rescuer, my help; Oh Lord do not delay!"

This prayer, the Entrance Antiphon from the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time is very apt for us all in the present difficult and different times. We feel frightened and vulnerable with all the conflicting media reports. These contribute to our feelings of fear and anxiety as to what is happening.

Many of our friends have stopped watching the news or reading newspapers. This ultimately leaves them losing hope and trust in all aspects of our daily life and in the life of the community around us.

We are like St Peter when he lost faith as he was walking on the water towards Jesus. He began to sink. We need Jesus's help to stop us sinking in this life and not lose hope. Hope is the forerunner of faith.

We need to ask God for help to restore our hope in ourselves and in mankind despite many setbacks. We must trust in Him that it will pass. We need His help to learn to believe in His word.

The story of the boy possessed by a demon in Mark chapter 6 shows what we need to do. When Jesus asked the father of the boy "*Do you believe*?" the father replied: "*I believe*. *Help thou my unbelief*."

This father hoped for an outcome that would make his son's life better in some way and he put his faith in Jesus.

As the disciples asked Jesus afterwards why no one else had been able to cast out the demon Jesus replied

"This is the kind of demon which can only be driven out by prayer"

This is our lesson- St Peter was only saved by Our lord's help - we need to pray that we have the courage and belief to ask for help in our prayers.
