and follow you more nearly. Amen.

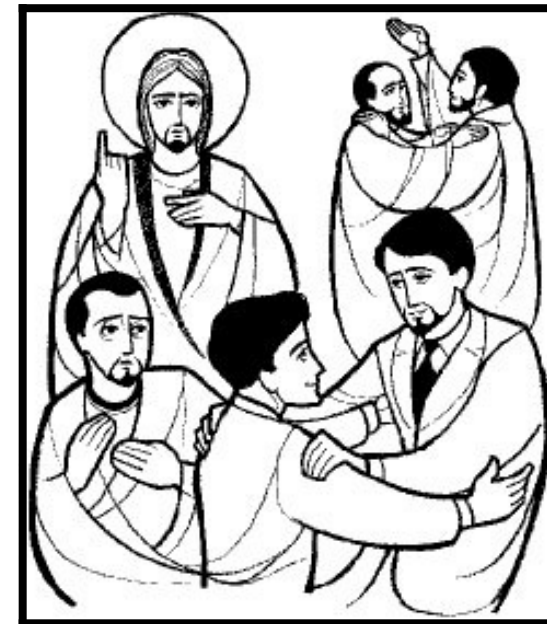
