GIFT AID.

As you will be aware, we receive a rebate on offertory donations which are classified as Gift Aided, this includes Standing Orders from many parishioners and donations made on the 'Dona' machine where you 'tick' the gift aid box (note that you only need to identify yourself once (for each card used). For the Financial Year ending April 2024, we received a rebate of £7039.42 However, in 2024, we were able to take advantage of the 'Gift Aid Small Donations Scheme'.

This allows us to claim for some of the monies collected in the offertory plate and the Dona machine non-gift aid donations.

We received a sum of £1523.63. making a total rebate of £8563.05. Which shows the importance of gift-aid to our income. We are grateful for your continued financial support for the work of the parish.
