THE EUCHARIST - A GIFT TO CELEBRATE



The Eucharist is at the very heart of the Church's life since Jesus is fully present: body, blood, soul and divinity. We meet Jesus by receiving him in Holy Communion and in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The Church celebrates this divine gift in several ways, including an International Eucharistic Congress every few years. It is a gathering of laity, religious and clergy from around the world bearing witness to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. One takes place this year, 8th-15th September in Quito, the capital of Ecuador.

The logo depicts the Cross of Jesus entering the flesh of the world to heal the wounds opened by sin. The open Heart of Christ on the Cross represents the source of the love that makes all things new. The light of the Eucharist gives a new direction to human history because God continues to gather his people around the Word of life and the living Bread descended from heaven. The logo also depicts the position of Quito at 0° latitude, close to the equator.

To coincide with this event the Catholic Church of England and Wales will have its own gathering at St Mary's College, Oscott on 14th September, to renew and deepen our devotion to the Eucharist.

Here at St Michael's, we have the opportunity to meet Our Lord in the Eucharist during our monthly Holy Hours (weekly in Advent and Lent). During these times of quiet we try to set aside our daily distractions and listen for the Lord speaking to us. This is truly a gift to celebrate.
