### Thought for the week 29th Sunday of the Year (B) 20th October, 2024

'Anyone who wants to be first [...] must be slave to all."

In today's gospel James and John appear to be getting a little above themselves, a little over-ambitious, asking for seats alongside Our Lord in Heaven. Jesus uses this as a good opportunity to remind them - and us - of the virtue of humility and the importance of service of others.

When St Augustine was writing about the fundamentals of Christian belief and practice, he commented "If you ask me what is the first thing in religion - I should reply: the first, the second and the third thing therein is humility."

Humility is often referred to as the queen of virtues. Pride is a sin with which many of us struggle for most of our lives. It could be argued that much of the sinful behaviour in the world today has its root in pride, arrogance, a sense of selfentitlement. I once heard a priest describe pride as the sin we finally conquer in the grave!

St Francis de Sales remarked that the essence of pride is self-deception and so it would follow that honest self-knowledge lies at the root of conquering the sin of pride. We can best gain self-knowledge through prayer, through asking God for help in knowing ourselves as He knows us. We have each been given gifts and to deny these is false humility. We've probably all been guilty of that to an extent. Compliments such as: "You are so good at making cakes, playing the piano, building flat-pack furniture, solving difficult problems, etc" can often be met by "No, really I'm not!" Humility lies in accepting the gifts we have been given so generously and thanking God for them while reflecting the glory back to Him. Let us pray for honesty and humility.
