Well, what a summer we are having!!

I can well understand Job's unhappiness!

It isn't just the weather that gets him down, he can't help feeling that God is to blame for all his difficulties. Yet, somehow he also has an absolute belief that the same God's love for him is equally ever present and equally unshakeable.

In the passage from which our first reading is a part, in response to Job's complaining, God tells him that not only did he create the seas and the storms but he sets their bounds; he holds the snow and the hail yet causes the rain to fall making the wastelands green and fresh. The Lord holds all of creation in his hands and in the realisation of this immense power and purpose, beyond human comprehension, Job finds peace in God's love and overwhelming awesomeness.

In the same way, the disciples were terrified by the storm on the lake and were scared that their boat would be swamped. Their natural human fear and concern in the face of the power of nature to overwhelm them is very evident. When Jesus calms the storm, they too see evidence of that power and overwhelming awesomeness of God

So what does this mean for you and me?

When things are going wrong and everything seems to be against us, when friends seem distant or absent and we can't see a way out of our distress, God is still there! His awesome power, his absolute love and that overwhelming awesomeness that Job and the disciples experienced is there for each one of us.

All that is asked of us is faith.
