and you give them their food in due season.

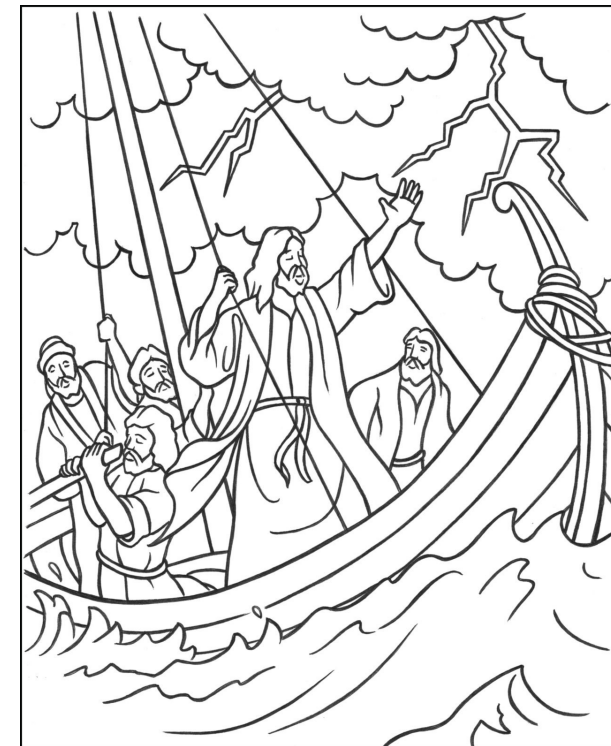
