save that of knowing that we do your holy will. Amen.

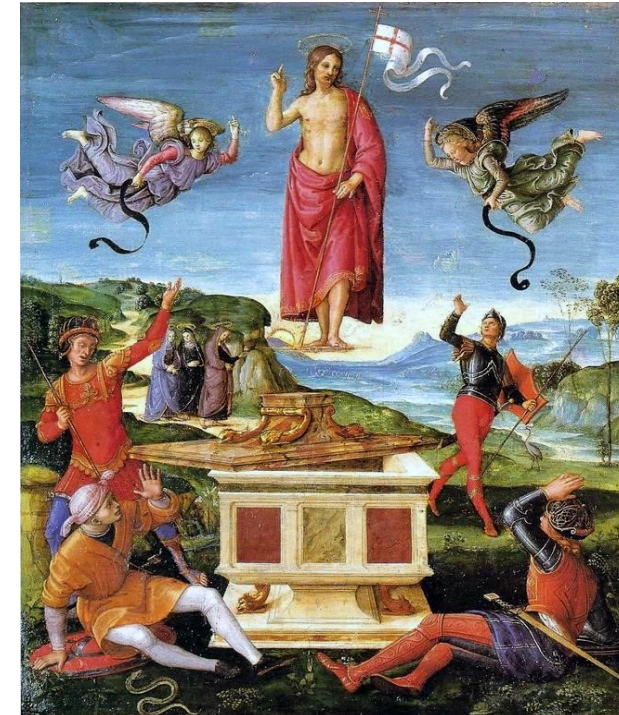
Communion Antiphon: Christ, our Passover, has been sacrificed, alleluia;
