One theme in today's Gospel is **readiness:** 

"Be ready because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."

What we need to remember is that that unexpected hour might be the present moment:

that Jesus enters our lives unexpectedly in unexpected people, in unexpected ways, at unexpected moments:

that it may be the person or event that we experience as an *interruption* which is actually God's *eruption* into our life that day:

that it may be the experience that we see as *disaster* which is the greatest opportunity for the experience of *grace*.

**Readiness**. It means being ready for how God chooses to come, not for how we choose God to come.

There could be no better place to start - if you haven't read it - than his *Apologia Pro Vita Sua ('In defence of one's life')*, his spiritual autobiography and account of his journey to embracing the faith of the Catholic Church.
