# MEDITATION FOR THE WEEK FROM FR COLIN BLAYNEY

Today's Gospel is really a 'Part 2' of what would have been last Sunday's Gospel if we hadn't been celebrating Ss Peter and Paul. And it spoke about the depth of commitment involved in being a disciple. And one thing that stands out in today's Gospel is that Jesus sends his disciples out in pairs. He doesn't send them alone. Even when Jesus first called his disciples he formed them into a group: the band of apostles. We don't ever see Jesus calling a disciple and sending them off alone: his call always draws people into the body of disciples. Which makes it clear that Jesus expects that discipleship involves interaction, cooperation, common action with others: that discipleship involves community. Too often though religion is turned into a 'God and me' thing: 'I'm a very spiritual person, but I don't need religion.' But in fact we don't find the Lord unless we find our brothers and sisters. The Gospel constantly reminds us that discipleship is always discipleship with others. The thing is that it's much easier to be a disciple alone: we can keep control of our own life, do things on our own terms, do things if and when we want to. Very much the desire of the 'me-generation'. But being - truly - part of a community is much more disruptive. It's the difference between merely being in church together and being Church together. Which involves compromise, sacrificing some of my own will and desires, giving as well as receiving. In today's world 'community' is all too often equated with a club membership. But a club member only dips into the activities of the club when, and insofar, as they need them. Today's Gospel reminds us that Christian community is what is given to us by God, who calls us to give ourselves to it. As with all of discipleship community is marked with the sign of the Cross, the ultimate sign of self-giving sacrifice.
