- 1. Review of last meeting's minutes
 - a. Covid Restrictions lifted Dcn B will remove the stickers from the benches.

 - f. The family entertainment day has had to be postponed due to personal reasons.
 - g. The Sustainability Group are changing their name to the Thoughtful Living Group and the Walk Against Hunger (CAFOD) on April 9th generated a lot of interest and 20 parishioners joined in and helped to raise £400 for CAFOD
 - h. In May, Catherine a representative from Mary's Meals will come and talk after Masses

Lent and Easter

It was felt the services were well attended and went well. Whilst people were reluctant to sign up to have their feet washed – we did eventually get 12 people – and it was suggested that the sign-up sheet be put out a little earlier next year and perhaps people could be asked if they would like to take part.

Serving the Parish

Once the First Holy Communions have taken place it is intended to recruit more altar servers and begin a series of training sessions for all the servers so that more roles can be reintroduced, e.g. cross bearer, candles, thurifer and help them to understand better what they are participating in.

Coffee & cake is being reintroduced after the 10.30am Mass. However very have committed to helping on a regular basis. Hopefully others will be encouraged to help once it has started.

Some members originally part of the 10.30am choir have decided to commit themselves to the 9.00am Mass. This left the 10.30am choir depleted but a significant number of new recruits has seen a rejuvenation of the choir.

School Links

Preparations are in hand for both first Holy Communion and Confirmation and is being coordinated by Mrs West and others from the school. FHC dates are 19th and 26 June and 10th July for Confirmation. The Archbishop will confer the Sacrament of Confirmation. The music for the all liturgies will be

organised by the school. Janice and Eveline are ready to prepare the flowers for these dates.

The Sustainability Group

The group has changed their name to Thoughtful Living and will produce a second newsletter later in May and a display for the boards at the back of church once they are replaced.
