**Parish Weekend (21-23<sup>rd</sup> September):**

Tickets for the Silver Band concert will be printed by KS – It was agreed that a small fee of £5 will be charged for the event. Children can attend free of charge. MOD has agreed to organise the raffle again. KS has asked for volunteers setting up the hall.

Christmas Masses are confirmed as last year: December 24<sup>th</sup> 5pm and 8pm. Christmas Day 10.30pm.
