Pope Francis named last year's jubilee 'Pilgrims of Hope'. This was certainly a prophetic name, as a real and deep hope in the Church seems to be growing of late. Let me give you a few headlines that have come out recently: 33 million pilgrims and tourists came to Rome for the jubilee last year, including around 1 million young people for the jubilee of youth. The Vatican before Christmas published its latest data from 2024 showing growth in the Church on every continent (I think Antarctica is excluded!). France recorded a record number of adult baptisms at Easter 2025. Priests who work in UK universities are seeing an increase in the number of young people, particularly young men exploring or returning to the faith. Many seminaries in the US are beginning to fill up again and in the UK we are seeing a growth in the number of applicants to seminary. All this news is very exciting. In the seminary there is a growing zeal and desire for mission, a sense of growth and hope in the Church, resulting in a significant improvement in morale and optimism amongst my brother seminarians. In one sense, this should not surprise us. Jesus promised that he would be with His Church forever, and ultimately, He is the one leading us and inviting all to encounter Him. I hope that this will also be an encouragement to all the parishes in our deanery to continue to be places of community, charity and encounter with God, especially to be welcoming to the many who are seeking to know God.

Next week, I will look at answering the call.
